GLS 399 – FR 399 France in Global Society :

(Global Studies, History-Urbanism-Sociology, Political Science, Sustainable Development)

(3 credits)

The primary objective of this course is to explore French culture, art and history, with a specific emphasis on issues such as sustainable development, public policy, wellness and customs. Special attention will be dedicated to gaining insights into the significant challenges faced by France today. Through local visits and a hands-on project, students will develop a better understanding of French global society as well as other various aspects of French social life, including food, fashion, and education.

The course also highlights the architectural history of Paris, offering students a foundation to better appreciate the diversity present in each area of the city.

SUNY in Paris Summer Program

French Language and Grammar Course (3 credits)

Students will be placed according to their proficiency in one of the following levels:

FRE 110 - Beginning

FRE 210 - Low Intermediate

FRE 310 – Intermediate

FRE 342 - High Intermediate

FRE 381 – Advanced

Students will take their French language course for a total of 40 hours plus a phonetics course for 10 hours totaling 50 hours.
