<u>French Grammar</u>. Students will be placed according to their proficiency in one of the following levels:

FRE 110 - Beginning

FRE210 - Low Intermediate

FRE310 – Intermediate

FRE342 - High Intermediate

FRE381 - Advanced

Students will take their French language course for a total of 40 hours plus a phonetics course for 8 hours totaling 48 hours.

GLS 399: France in Global Society (3 credits) taught in English (40 hours):

This course gives a look into French culture and French organizations and their operations in and outside of France, with a special focus on Europe. Incorporated in the course are weekly visits to French and International companies* and two study-field trips. One of the trips will be to the Champagne Region to better understand France heritage and a second study-field trip to the European Parliament in Bruxelles to examine the European Community institution. The aim of the visits is to allow students to see and interact firsthand with the operations taking place.
